**Notice of Quarterly Public Hearing and 2018 Rules Review**

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4301.06, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission is required to hold no fewer than 4 public hearings each year for the purposes of hearing general comments and complaints as to its policies adopted pursuant to Chapters 4301 and 4303 of the Ohio Revised Code; considering other business and procedures of the Liquor Control Commission and receiving suggestions with respect thereto; and, for the dissemination of information to the public.

Additionally, the Commission will receive comments and testimony concerning the **2018** Administrative Rules subject to five-year-review listed below:

- 4301:1-1-05 Mixed beverages: requirements
- 4301:1-1-16 Closing authority
- 4301:1-1-17 Sanitation requirements
- 4301:1-1-52 Entertainment – prohibition against improper conduct
- 4301:1-1-53 Gambling, gambling devices and promotional contests
- 4301:1-1-68 Sales reports of B-1 permit holders
- 4301:1-1-72 Minimum markup on beer
- 4301:1-1-73 Differential pricing practices: manner and frequency of price changes for beer
- 4301:1-2-01 Definitions
- 4301:1-2-02 Procedures for accessing confidential personal information
- 4301:1-2-03 Valid reasons for accessing confidential personal information
- 4301:1-2-04 Confidentiality statutes
- 4301:1-2-05 Restricting and logging access to confidential personal information in computerized personal information systems

Finally, *except* for Rules 52 and 53, the Commission will consider a resolution authorizing staff to *Initial File* them as “No Change” rules with the Common Sense Initiative (“CSI”) and/or the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (“JCARR”). The Commission previously held public hearings regarding all these rules on August 18, September 14, and December 13, 2017; and on March 9, June 13 and August 17, 2018. No changes were recommended for these rules.

In compliance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission will hold a public hearing on **Friday, September 14, 2018, at 10:30 a.m.** The public hearing will be held in the Riffe Center at 77 South High Street, 19<sup>th</sup> floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Anyone who wishes to speak to the issues of Commission policy or rules or wishes to make comments to the Commission relating to its business may do so at this time.
